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Company Summary

Aaction Traffic commenced business in March 2007. The Company Principals have been engaged in the Traffic Control Industry for over a decade and have a vast knowledge of the traffic control industry.

Aaction Traffic is proud that it can offer customers a professional yet personalized service at our Branches and sites where traffic control is required.

Aaction Traffic has a professional team working throughout our Branches. The key personnel are a qualified Planning and Permit department, Workplace Health & Safety officers, Rehabilitation and Return to Work Manager and Fleet Coordinator.

Aaction Traffic comprises of two companies; Aaction Traffic Control Pty Ltd and Aaction Traffic Services Pty Ltd:

- Aaction Traffic Control Pty Ltd provides traffic control for all civil works and regional council works. This company has a Fair Work Enterprise Agreement (*Aaction Traffic Enterprise Agreement 2013*).
- Aaction Traffic Services Pty Ltd provides traffic control for construction works that come under the umbrella of union sites. Our EBA (*Aaction Traffic Services Pty Ltd and CMFEU Collective Agreement 2011-2015*) allows us to work on union sites.

Traffic Controllers are the forefront of our Company and we encourage personal development via in-house training and external training from other providers. This encourages a stable work force and leads to controllers being employed in continuous service for many years.

Aaction Traffic is a member of the Traffic Management Association of Queensland and Traffic Management Association of Australia.

Both companies have completed major projects which involved extensive planning and execution. We have introduced many changes over the years which have enabled our Company to manage some of these major projects.

Our Planning and Permit team have an excellent working relationship with the Brisbane City Council, Regional Councils, metropolitan police and regional police. For most projects, obtaining approved Permits/Council Certificates and Traffic Guidance Schemes is the most important step taken before works can take place.

Plant and Equipment

Aaction Traffic has over ninety (90) vehicles equipped with signage that is compliant with MRD standards.

Signage vehicles are all equipped with hazard lights, rotators, arrow boards and a reversing warning device.

All vehicles carry a First Aid Kit, a Fire Extinguisher and a safety and service Log Book.

Signage vehicles that work in remote locations are also equipped with broadband 2-way radios.
